I have reviewed the application for Brookline Mobile Food submitted by Super Star Ice-Cream Truck out of Lynn, MA. The owner, Hani Hindi, is requesting permission to sell packaged ice cream in any public area, street or park in Brookline.

Due to several complaints that we have received about the noise nuisance associated with ice cream trucks (persistent repetitive music) and their presence in the parks, I would recommend that the truck not be allowed within in any public park (paved paths etc..) except for parking lot areas and that they are permitted in the lot area for no longer than 30 minutes. I also suggest that if they are on the perimeter of a park it should not be for longer than 30 minutes. In addition, the music should not be permitted when the truck is stationary. The music can play upon their approach to the park, but should then be turned off when at or abutting the site.

It would also be helpful to see a proposed route to understand where Super Star Ice-Cream intends to spend their time in Town.

I hope that this is helpful and consistent with other comments that you have received.

Please be advised that this Department has no objection to the issuance of a Mobile Food Vendor License to the above noted applicant.

This recommendation is under the following conditions:

SUBJECT: **Mobile Food Vendor License (Ice Cream Truck)

The Department of Planning and Community Development periodically receives complaints about loud music playing for long periods of time from ice cream trucks, especially when located at or near parks. We do not know whether those complaints to our Department were regarding this particular ice cream vendor.

I spoke with Hani Hindi, owner of Super Star Ice Cream Truck, on July 3rd, and he noted that while he would like permission to be located on any public street or public parking area at a park, he is not interested in locating at metered parking spaces. He also noted that he is not interested in being located in any single space for longer than 30 minutes, nor playing music while stationary.

Therefore, I recommend the Selectmen approve the Mobile Food Vendor License subject to the following conditions:

1. Vendor shall not be located at any metered parking spot;
2. Vendor shall not remain at any other single location for longer than 30 minutes; and
3. Vendor shall not play music while stationary.

Mr. Kleckner,

I have reviewed the application submitted by Hani Hindi dba "Super Star Ice Cream Truck" for a Mobile Food Permit issued by the Board of Selectmen and I offer the following comments:

- The application does not indicate the exact locations that the vehicle operator intends to stop at. I understand that the nature of the business is that the vehicle will stop in both residential and commercial areas, for a short period of time, as determined by available clientele but I believe that
 - the terms of the permit should require the owner to pay the meter fee, if they utilize a parking meter, for the period of time that they are occupying the space to ensure that Town of Brookline does not lose parking meter revenue;
 - the truck be required to abide by posted parking restrictions and time limits if not at a metered parking space; and
 - that the truck be required to comply with Traffic Rules & Regulations Article V, Section 6 which is:





Dear Mr Maloney:

Members of our condo association have complained about noise pollution caused by the Good Humor Truck that parks across Goddard Avenue in the parking lot for Larz Anderson Park. The Truck comes frequently on weekday evenings and on weekends. It plays a children's song that lasts about 15 seconds - 4 times per minute - and that is repeated continuously. If the truck is here for one hour, the song may be repeated 240 times. If the truck is here for two hours, it may be repeated 480 times. This is aggravating to several residents and may be considered noise pollution.

We do NOT want to get rid of the Good Humor Truck, but we would like to have the song played less often and, if possible, varied. Apparently more than one song is available on the broadcast equipment used by the truck, but in general only one tune is played.

We would like to propose a compromise: Could music be played for one minute every half hour (4 times) and could the driver play more than one song? Could a compromise such as this become one condition of the license which the truck probably needs to do business on our town property?
