Hi All,

The following substitute motion leaves Article 7.7 of the By-Laws unchanged except for increasing the penalties for violations listed in Section 7.7.5 in accordance with those proposed in WA 12, thus immediately (starting with the coming winter) encouraging increased compliance by making the penalties for violations more onerous, while leaving the more problematic and controversial changes proposed for the remainder of Article 7.7 for future consideration and possible modification. This substitute motion has been accepted by the Moderator.

Proposed Substitute Motion under Article 12: To amend Section 7.7.5 of the Town By-laws as follows and to make corresponding changes in Section 10.3 :

SECTION 7.7.5 PENALTIES

The violation of any provision of Sections 7.7.1 and 7.7.2 of this Article 7.7 shall be subject to a fine of \$100.00 for the first violation, \$150.00 for the second violation, and \$200.00 for each subsequent violation in any fiscal year. The violation of any provision of Section 7.7.3 of this Article 7.7 shall be noted with a warning for the first violation, and subject to a fine of \$50.00 for the second violation and \$100.00 for each subsequent violation in any fiscal year. The violation of any provision of Section 7.7.4 of this Article 7.7 shall be subject to a fine of \$250.00.
